ORDER ADOPTING JOINT STATEMENT OF UNRESOLVED ISSUES

On August 8, 2007, MCImetro Access Transmission Service, L.L.C. d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon Access") filed its petition for arbitration with the Commission pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996, Section 386.230, RSMo 2000, 4 CSR 240-2 and 4 CSR 240-36. In its petition, Verizon Access identified two issues to be resolved by the Arbitrator. Those issues are:

- 1. What compensation should apply to virtual NXX traffic under the ICA?
- 2. Where Verizon Access is not purchasing UNE loops or resold services from Embarq, should Embarq be permitted to charge Verizon Access a monthly charge for "maintenance and storage" of customers' basic directory listing information that is based on Embarq's tariffed rate for maintaining and storing additional directory listings?

On September 5, the parties jointly filed their statement of unresolved issues. The joint statement is identical to the issues originally identified in Verizon Access's petition. Consequently, the Commission will adopt the jointly filed issues list as being the only two issues requiring resolution by the Arbitrator.
