REQUEST FOR NOTICE OF INEFFECTIVE TARIFF REVISION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), through the undersigned counsel, and recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issue a Notice that the attempted tariff revisions in the tariff filing JL-2011-0327 are not effective, and respectfully states the following:

- 1. On December 28, 2010, Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Time Verizon") filed tariff revisions that were assigned the tariff tracking number JL-2011-0327. The proposed revisions were filed with a three-day effective date, purporting to become effective on January 1, 2011.
- 2. Although a company may file a rate revision on a shorter time period, the tariff submission at issue indicates text changes, which can only be made on 30-day filing. See 4 CSR 240-3.545(18).

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue a Notice in which it advises Verizon that the tariff filing is not effective by operation of law and will not become effective unless it is submitted with a 30-day effective date.
