1	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Good morning. Welcome to
2	the procedural conference in File Number WC-2017-0095 and
3	File Number SC-2017-0096. Both concerns complaints by
4	Staff of the Commission versus Missouri Utilities Company
5	and Gary Cover.
6	We'll begin today by taking entries of
7	appearance, beginning with Staff.
8	MS. FORCK: This is Marcie Forck from Staff
9	of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Also here
10	with me is Jacob Westen. Our contact information is on
11	file with the court reporter.
12	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And I don't see
13	anyone here from Missouri Utilities or from the Office of
14	Public Counsel. So we'll deal with Staff exclusively
15	here.
16	I had a couple of questions about the case
17	that you might be able to enlighten me on. First of all,
18	we have two separate cases here, one water and the other
19	sewer. Is there any reason not to consolidate them?
20	MS. FORCK: No, Judge.
21	JUDGE WOODRUFF: I will take care of that and
22	make everything a little bit procedurally simpler.
23	I notice that there was a partial payment
24	made by Mr. Cover along with his complaint. I assume
25	that's been applied to

MS. FORCK: Yes. 1 2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: -- it? 3 MS. FORCK: And so the remaining balance is 4 still due. I haven't heard anything from Mr. Cover or 5 from our technical staff that collects that that says 6 that he's made any further payments. 7 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And then there was mention 8 of a sale, that it was -- been approved. Do you know 9 anything about the status of the sale? 10 MR. WESTEN: Your Honor, I have not heard 11 anything about the status of the sale. And to be frank, 12 the pleading and document included in Mr. Cover's answer 13 is the first I had heard of that sale. 14 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. I assume that you've 15 checked with your technical staff as well? 16 MR. WESTEN: I have not conferred directly 17 with technical staff. But they have not mentioned, 18 brought it up to me specifically. 19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Then final question 20 is about the claim against Gary Cover as an individual as His answer indicated that he believes he has 21 recei ver. 22 judicial and administrative immunity. 23 Does Staff have any position on that? 24 wish to continue with leaving Mr. Cover in the complaint? 25 You don't have to tell me the answer now. I'm just

2	MS. FORCK: Yeah, if we can let you know
3	after today.
4	JUDGE WOODRUFF: That's fine. That will be
5	fine.
6	MS. FORCK: Just to verify with the
7	decision-makers.
8	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. I just wanted to
9	bring it up.
10	MS. FORCK: Sure.
11	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Well, then, what I'll ask
12	you to do is give me a proposed procedural schedule by
13	December 1st. You can email how the Staff would like to
14	proceed to resolve this case. And if you hear anything
15	from Mr. Cover, of course you can include his thoughts on
16	that, if he has something. If you can't all agree, you
17	can file something separately, and the Commission can
18	deci de.
19	MS. FORCK: Okay. Thank you, Judge.
20	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Anything else we need to
21	take up while we're on the record?
22	MS. FORCK: I don't believe so.
23	JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well, thank you
24	then. We are adjourned.
25	MS. FORCK: Thank you.
