**ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND
ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

TeleHub Network Services Corporation applied to the Public Service Commission on May 29, 1997, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440 RSMo 1994¹. Applicant asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. Applicant is a Illinois corporation, with its principal office located at 1375 Tri-State Parkway, Suite 250, Gurnee, Illinois 60031.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on June 10, directing parties wishing to intervene in the case to file their requests by June 25. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo.App. 1989). Since no one has asked permission to intervene

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That TeleHub Network Services Corporation is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to the conditions of certification set out above.

2. That TeleHub Network Services Corporation is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. The following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:


