

Overview: Metropolitan Telecommunications of Missouri, Inc. (Metropolitan), a competitive local exchange telecommunications carrier, was granted a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service effective September 2, 2005 in Case No. CA-2005-0425.

The granting of the certificate was based on the following conditions:

- 1. That Metropolitan shall have originating and terminating access rates no greater than the lowest Commission-approved corresponding access rates in effect for each ILEC within whose service area Metropolitan seeks authority to provide service, unless authorized by the Commission pursuant to Sections 392.220 and 392.230 RSMo 2000.
- 2. That the certificate and competitive service classification for switched exchange access is granted conditioned on the continued applicability of Section 392.200 RSMo 2000, and the requirement that any increases in switched access services rates above the maximum switched access service rates set forth herein shall be made pursuant to Sections 392.220 and 392.230 RSMo 2000, and not Sections 392.500 and 392.510 RSMo 2000.
- 3. That if the directly competing ILEC, in whose service area Metropolitan is operating, decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, Metropolitan shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates in the directly competing ILEC's service area within 30 days of the directly competing ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap.
- 4. That Metropolitan shall not conduct business in Missouri until the Commission approves its tariffs and interconnection agreements.
