**SECTION 3 -- SERVICES, LOCATION, PRICES AND CHARGES**

**3.1 Description of Service**

Worldwide Fiber Networks will provide high capacity transport on a leased long-term basis. There will be no standard offering as all contracts for high capacity transport will be negotiated and performed on an individual case basis.

**3.2 Location of Service**

Worldwide Fiber Network's intent is to design, install and maintain a national fiber optic cable route consisting of two primary east-west routes and three primary north-south routes.

**3.3 Rates for Service**

<u>Description</u>	<u>Rate</u>
High capacity transport at OC-48	ICB

Private line services will be made available to customers in a non-discriminatory manner. Rates for Interexchange Dedicated Access, Private Line, non-switched services will be determined on an Individual Case Basis (ICB). ICB rates will be structured to recover the Company's cost of providing the service and will be made available to the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff upon request on a proprietary basis. ICB rates will not be used for switched services.

**3.4 Application for Service**

Application for service must be made in writing. The name(s) of the customer(s) desiring to use the service must be set forth in the application for service.

**3.5 Deposits**

Deposits and/or advanced payments are not required.
