

By the authority vested in the Secretary of State under section 536.023, RSMo 2000, the secretary amends a rule as follows:

4 CSR 240-123.030 Seals is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on March 17, 2003 (28 MoReg 547). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.
