## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Commission is directing Staff to file a supplement to its request for additional time ("motion").<sup>1</sup>

In the motion, Staff asks the Commission to extend the due date of Staff's recommendation until after other parties have responded to data requests. Staff also asks the Commission to set a pre-hearing conference a week before the extended due date. But what the extended due date is to be, Staff does not say. Staff does not propose an extended due date, state when responses to data requests are expected, or show when the data requests were served. The tariff's suspension expires in 29 days.

The Commission cannot schedule any event without assigning it a date. This action's procedural history clearly demonstrates the need for dates certain. Therefore, the Commission will order Staff to supplement the motion as follows.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than noon on June 30, 2011, Staff shall file a supplement to its request for additional time.
