ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES AND DIRECTING NOTICE

On November 3, 2009, Big River Telephone Company, LLC, filed tariff sheets designed to introduce foreign exchange service as a new service offering. Big River also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment in which it requests that the Commission approve the tariff sheets to become effective in ten days.

Big River explains that the reason for the tariff filing and for the request for expedited treatment is so that customers in the Huntsville exchange, who have been assigned a Salisbury NXX code, may make and receive local calls without Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation, the incumbent local exchange company, perceiving them as virtual NXX calls. Approval of the tariffs will also avoid the necessity of Big River having to be assigned a new block of 10,000 numbers to serve only a handful of customers in the area.

The Commission will shorten the time for responses to the Motion for Expedited Treatment. In addition, the Commission shall direct the filing of a recommendation from its Staff and direct the Data Center of the Commission to provide a copy of this order to Chariton Valley.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

Any response to the motion for expedited treatment filed by Big River
 Telephone Company on November 3, 2009, shall be filed no later than November 9, 2009.

- 2. No later than November 9, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the tariff or a response to the motion for expedited treatment indicating the earliest date on which it can file a recommendation.
- 3. The Data Center of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation.
 - 4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
