
Attached for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") is a negotiated Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") by and between Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC ("TWCIS") and Consolidated Communications of Missouri Company ("Consolidated") for the transport and termination of local telecommunications and ISP-bound traffic in the State of Missouri. TWCIS and Consolidated respectfully request approval of this Agreement pursuant to Section 252 of the Act.

The parties submit that this Agreement does not discriminate against any other telecommunications carrier and is consistent with the public interest. Since this is a negotiated Agreement and does not discriminate against third parties, it may be approved without the necessity of a public hearing.

Pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Act, this Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated Agreement between TWCIS and Consolidated within ninety (90) days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the Agreement or any portion thereof discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Agreement, or the implementation of such Agreement or portion thereof is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
