1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Good morning. We're on the
3 record. This is the prehearing conference in Case No.
4 WC-2007-0038, Office of the Public Counsel versus Central
5 Jefferson County Utilities, Incorporated.

6 I'll note for the record that Case No. S, as in
7 Sam, C-2007-0039 has been consolidated into this case.

8 I would like to get entries of appearance from
9 counsel, please, beginning with the Office of the Public
10 Counsel.

11 MS. BAKER: Christina Baker, Office of the
12 Public Counsel. Address is P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City,
13 Missouri, 65102, here for the Office of the Public Counsel
14 and for the public.

15 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Ms. Baker, thank
16 you, and I believe I've met you. I'm Ron Pridgin. It is
17 a pleasure to meet you.

18 MS. BAKER: Nice to meet you.

19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: And on behalf of Central
20 Jefferson County Utilities, Incorporated, please?

21 MR. ENGLAND: Thank you, your Honor. Let the
22 record reflect the appearance of the W.R. England and Dean
23 Cooper. Our address is Brydon, Swearengen & England, Post
24 Office Box 456, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102, appearing
25 on behalf of Central Jefferson County Utilities.

1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you. And also note that
2 Mr. Dandino from the Office of Public Counsel is present
3 in the room.

4 On behalf of the Staff of the Commission,
5 please?

6 MR. KRUEGER: Keith R. Krueger, for the Staff of
7 the Missouri Public Service Commission. My address is
8 P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.

9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Krueger, thank you. I don't
10 believe I have any intervenors or any other parties. Is
11 there anyone else who wishes to enter an appearance?

12 All right. Hearing no responses, of course, the
13 purpose of this prehearing is to allow everyone to speak
14 face-to-face at least once, and hopefully start to resolve
15 some issues, if possible, and also to start looking for
16 hearing dates.

17 Our calendar is up on the 9th floor, and I wish
18 everyone well in trying to find a date any time in the
19 near future. And in all honesty, there are probably
20 assorted dates here and there, but we may be looking at
21 the spring before there are any open hearing dates. So
22 I'm sure all the parties are aware of the Commission's
23 calendar.

24 Are there any pending motions that the parties
25 need to have resolved fairly quickly, or is there anything

1 else that Counsel want to bring to my attention before I
2 conclude the prehearing conference and allow you to speak?

3 MS. BAKER: No.

4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. Hearing nothing from the
5 parties, you have access to this room until 5:00. I am up
6 on the 9th floor, and the calendar is also up on the 9th
7 floor. So if you need me, I will be available throughout
8 the day, and you can check the calendar to see what kind
9 of dates are available.

10 If I'm not mistaken, a proposed procedural
11 schedule is due from the parties in a week. And,
12 obviously, if the parties need more time, just please file
13 a motion, and I would likely grant that without any
14 trouble.

15 Anything else from the parties before we go off
16 the record?
