

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, CONT'D.

2.5 Deposits

The Company does not normally require a deposit from the Customer. In the event that a deposit is required by the Company, it will be collected, maintained and returned in accordance with Commission rules and regulations. Deposits shall bear interest at the rate of 9% per annum.

2.6 Advance Payments

The Company does not require advance payments from the Customer.

2.7 Taxes and Fees

- 2.7.1 All state and local taxes (i.e., gross receipts tax, sales tax, municipal utilities tax) are listed as separate line items and are not included in the quoted rates. For pre-paid services, taxes and fees shall be included in the rates and charges stated in the Company's rate schedule for this service.
- 2.7.2 The Company may adjust its rates and charges or impose additional rates and charges on its Customers in order to recover amounts it is required by governmental or quasigovernmental authorities to collect from or pay to others in support of statutory or regulatory programs. Examples of such programs include, but are not limited to, the Universal Service Fund, the Primary Interexchange Carrier Charge, and compensation to payphone service providers for the use of their payphones to access the Company's service. The Company will submit these changes to the Missouri Public Service Commission for prior approval.
