On April 26, 2021, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed two applications requesting that the Commission grant it Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCNs) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water and sewer system in and around the City of Eureka, in St. Louis County, Missouri. Also on April 26, 2021, MAWC filed a *Motion to Consolidate*, requesting that the two CCN applications be consolidated as they have parties in common, and common questions of law and fact. The Commission set a time to object to the motion. No objections were received.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) allows for the consolidation of cases with related questions of law or fact. Since these cases involve related questions of law and fact, the Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MAWC's Motion to Consolidate File Nos. WA-2021-0376 and SA-2021-0377, with File No. WA-2021-0376 being the lead case is granted.
