ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

ON April 14, 1995, Midwest Independent Coin Payphone Association (MICPA) filed an application to intervene in this case. MICPA states in its application that its filing is beyond the time set for intervention due to the short period for intervention and the need to get officers of the association to approve the application. MICPA states further that its interests in this proceeding are different from those of the general public or other parties to the proceeding.

The Commission has considered MICPA's application and finds that it should be granted. Even though filed beyond the time established by Commission order, the intervention will not affect the schedule and MICPA does have interests different from those of the general public in this case.

- 1. That Midwest Independent Coin Payphone Association be hereby granted intervention in this case.
