ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND TIME
FOR FILING PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 9, 2007, Leesa Forsee filed a complaint against Aquila, Inc. The Commission issued an order that, among other things, required the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than September 17.

On September 11, Aquila filed a Motion to Suspend Time for Filing Proposed Procedural Schedule. Aquila explains that a schedule is no longer necessary because the parties have agreed in principle on how to settle their dispute. Because of that agreement, Aquila asks the Commission to suspend the requirement to file a schedule.

The Commission finds Aquila's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion to Suspend Time for Filing Proposed Procedural Schedule filed by Aquila, Inc., is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on September 13, 2007.
