ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO HOLD IN ABEYANCE

On June 11, 2007, Wilbur A. Strawn filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL). KCPL filed its answer to the complaint on July 12, 2007, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its Report on July 19, 2007.

On July 23, 2007, the Commission issued an order scheduling a prehearing conference for August 6, and directing the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than August 13. Following the issuance of that order KCPL filed a motion requesting that the Commission hold this proceeding in abeyance until August 31, 2007. In support of its motion, KCPL advised the Commission that it believes it has reached an agreement with Mr. Strawn that will resolve his complaint. KCPL seeks the requested abeyance to give the parties an opportunity to execute a settlement agreement and to give Mr. Strawn an opportunity to withdraw his complaint. The Commission finds KCPL's request to be reasonable and will grant it.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The prehearing conference to be held on August 6, 2007, is cancelled to be rescheduled at a later date in the event a settlement agreement is not reached by the parties.
2. The jointly proposed procedural schedule currently due on or before August 20, 2007, shall not be required to be filed unless and until otherwise ordered by this Commission.
3. This order shall become effective on July 24, 2007.
