ORDER LIFTING STAY AND DIRECTING EXPEDITED RESPONSE

The applicants¹ filed written testimony on June 4, 2015, in response to inquiries made by the Missouri Attorney General. With that testimony, applicants filed a motion to lift² the stay, which the Commission imposed on these proceedings pending the Missouri Attorney General's investigation,³ for the purpose of accepting the filing of the testimony. The Commission will do so, and will direct the Missouri Attorney General to file a response to that testimony, and will set a time for other parties to respond if they wish to do so. Such responses need not be in the form of responsive testimony, but shall state whether the responding party believes that concerns about the proposed transaction have been sufficiently resolved to allow for approval of the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The stay is lifted for the filings as described in the body of this order.
