ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING TIME FOR FILING

The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting the date for filing an application to intervene, directing Staff to file a recommendation, and directing notice in accordance with the *Response to Order*.¹ In that filing, the applicants indicated that the all political subdivisions, in which any assets described in the application are located, lie within Camden County and Miller County. Therefore, the Commission will direct that notice be sent notice to the clerks of those counties.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send the application to the county clerk of Camden County and to the county clerk of Miller County.
2. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than April 27, 2015.
3. No later than May 4, 2015, the Commission's staff shall file its recommendation on the application, with copies to the county clerk of Camden County and to the county clerk of Miller County.

4. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make this notice and order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the residents of Camden County and Miller County, and to the news media serving those residents.
