ORDER TO SUPPLEMENT APPLICATION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing the applicants to supplement

the application by listing each county where an affected political subdivision, as described

below, is located.

The supplement is necessary for the Commission to meet a statutory duty:

Any person seeking any order under this subsection authorizing the [transaction described in the application] shall, at the time of application for any such order, file with the commission a statement, [of] any, impact such [transaction] will have on the tax revenues of the political subdivisions in which any [assets described in the application] are located. The commission shall send a copy of all information obtained by it as to what . . . impact such [transaction] will have on the tax revenues of various political subdivisions to the county clerk of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located. [¹]

That language addresses impact on "affected" political subdivisions: those where the

assets are located. Some political subdivisions may cross county lines. Hence the

Commission's duty is to send information to the clerks of counties, not where the assets are

located, but where any affected political subdivision is located.

The application does not set forth the counties in which all affected political subdivisions are located because the commission's regulations do not require it to do so. But the Commission needs that information. Therefore, the Commission will order the application supplemented.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than April 9, 2015, the applicants shall file a supplement to the application listing each county in which an affected political subdivision, as described in the body of this order, is located.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
