**ORDER REJECTING FILING AND NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY**

On November 6, 2006, Iowa Wireless Services, LLC filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission an amendment to an interconnection agreement between Iowa Wireless and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri. It appears that Iowa Wireless filed this amendment in an attempt to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)(A). However, that cannot be ascertained with any certainty by review of the documents filed.

It appears that this application for proposed amendment should have been filed under 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)(C). Application made under this subsection of the rule must be made in compliance with Commission rules 4 CSR 240-2.040, .060 and .080. These regulations impose numerous requirements on any application filed with the Commission. The filing made by Iowa Wireless does not comply with many of these requirements. In particular, 4 CSR 240-2.080(1) requires that every pleading filed with the Commission be signed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri. In addition, 4 CSR 240-2.080(3) requires each pleading include a statement of requested relief. Iowa Wireless'

filing is not a pleading nor is it signed by an attorney and must be rejected. If Iowa Wireless chooses to appropriately submit an application, it may do so in this case.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Iowa Wireless Services, LLC's request for approval of an amendment to an interconnection agreement between Iowa Wireless and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri is rejected for failure to comply with applicable filing requirements.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to AT&T Missouri's legal counsel.
3. This order shall become effective on November 9, 2006.
