### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and recommends the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) approve the submitted Interconnection Agreement. For said recommendation, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 16, 2008, Syniverse Technologies, Inc. (Syniverse) filed its Application For Approval Of An Interconnection Agreement (Application) with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri (AT&T Missouri) under the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act).
- 2. Section 252(e)(1) of the Act provides "[a]ny interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies."
- 3. Section 252(e)(2) of the Act provides "[t]he State commission may only reject—(A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that—(i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity."
  - 4. Syniverse represents to the Commission that the Interconnection Agreement

was submitted pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.513(1) as an interconnection agreement arrived at through negotiation.

- 5. In the Commission's April 21, 2008, Order Directing Notice And Making Southwestern Bell Telephone Company D/B/A AT&T Missouri, A Party, the Commission's Data Center was ordered to send notice of the Application to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
  - 6. In the same Order, interested persons were allowed 20 days to file a motion for hearing.
- 7. As of May 21, 2008, the Commission has not received any motions requesting a hearing be set in this matter.
- 8. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, Staff states the Interconnection Agreement "1) [d]oes not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not party to the Agreement and 2) [i]s not against the public interest, convenience or necessity."
- 9. Additionally, Staff indicates in Appendix A that a serially numbered copy of the Interconnection Agreement was not submitted, and recommends the Commission direct the parties to submit such copy to Staff.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully recommends the Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement pursuant to 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, and direct the parties to submit a serially numbered copy of the Interconnection Agreement to Staff.
