SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, CONT'D.

2.14 Inspection, Testing and Adjustment

Upon reasonable notice, the facilities provided by the Company shall be made available to the Company for tests and adjustments as may be deemed necessary by the Company for maintenance. No interruption allowance will be granted for the time during which such tests and adjustments are made.

2.15 Tests, Pilots and Contests

The Company may conduct special tests or pilot programs at its discretion to demonstrate the ease of use and quality of its services. The Company may also waive a portion or all processing fees or installation fees for the winner of contests or other events sponsored or endorsed by the Company. From time to time, the Company may waive all processing fees for a Customer.

2.16 Terminal Equipment

The Company's facilities and service may be used with or terminated in Customer-provided terminal equipment or Customer-provided communications systems, such as a telephone set, PBX or key system. Such terminal equipment shall be furnished and maintained at the expense of the Customer, except as otherwise provided. The Customer is responsible for all costs at his or her premises, including personnel, wiring, electrical power, and the like, incurred in the use of the Company's service. When such terminal equipment is used, the equipment shall comply with the generally accepted minimum protective criteria standards of the telecommunications industry as endorsed by the Federal Communications Commission.
