MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Comes now FDF Communications Company d/b/a BPS Long Distance ("BPS Long Distance"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), and for its Motion for Expedited Treatment states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. On March 17, 2005, the Commission issued its Order Granting Staff Motion in which it advised Missouri telecommunications companies that they "may begin billing their customers the Missouri Universal Service Fund surcharge on May 1, 2005, if applicable."
- BPS Long Distance holds a certificate from the Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri and is a "telecommunications company" as defined in 386.020 (51), RSMo 2000.
- 3. On this same date, BPS Long Distance is filing a tariff sheet authorizing it to collect the Missouri Universal Service Fund surcharge from its customers. This tariff was not filed earlier because it was inadvertently omitted when counsel for BPS Long Distance was preparing and filing numerous Missouri Universal Service Fund tariffs for the companies represented by the firm. BPS Long Distance requests that the Commission approve this tariff on an expedited basis so that the company may begin collecting the surcharge from its customers as ordered by the Commission.

Wherefore BPS Long Distance respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve the tariff sheet authorizing it to collect the Missouri Universal Service Fund Surcharge from its customers as quickly as possible.

 - 3.12.1 Company will place on each retail end-user customer's bill, a surcharge equal to the Missouri Universal Service Fund percentage assessment ordered by the commission.
 - 3.12.2 The surcharge will appear as a separate line item detailed as "Missouri Universal Service Fund."
 - 3.12.3 The surcharge percentage will be applied to the total of each customer's charges for intrastate regulated telecommunications services that meet the definition of net jurisdictional revenues at 4 CSR 240-31.010(12).
