ANSWER OF VOICESTREAM WIRELESS CORPORATION AND WESTERN WIRELESS CORPORATION

Come now Respondents VoiceStream Wireless Corporation and Western Wireless Corporation ("VoiceStream" and "Western," respectively, or, as and when appropriate, collectively referred to as "Respondents"), and for their Answer in the captioned proceeding, state the following:

- 1. Respondents are without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations in paragraphs 1 through 16 of the Complaint, and therefore deny same.
- 2. Respondents admit the allegations in paragraph 17 of the Complaint.
- 3. VoiceStream admits the allegations in paragraph 18 of the Complaint that Mark Johnson is a contact person for VoiceStream, but states that the correct contact person for VoiceStream is Daniel Menser, whose address is VoiceStream Wireless Corporation, Corporate Counsel -- Regulatory Affairs, 12980 SE 38th Street, Bellevue, Washington 98006-7305.
- 4. Western Wireless admits the allegations in paragraph 19 of the Complaint.

- 5. Respondents are without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations in paragraph 20 of the Complaint, and therefore deny same.
- 6. Respondents admit the allegations in paragraph 21 of the Complaint.
- 7. Respondents are without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations in paragraphs 22 through 24 of the Complaint, and therefore deny same.
- 8. Respondents admit the allegations in paragraphs 25 through 27 of the Complaint.
- 9. Respondents admit the allegations in paragraph 28 of the Complaint that they have not entered into agreements with Complainants to compensate them for the termination of intraMTA or interMTA traffic, are without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations that they have terminated wireless-originated traffic to Complainants' exchanges through Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") transit services or facilities, and deny all other allegations in paragraph 28.
- 10. VoiceStream admits the allegations in paragraph 29 of the Complaint that it has received certain invoices from certain Complainants containing charges for traffic allegedly delivered to those Complainants' exchanges, is without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations concerning the SWBT Cellular Transiting Usage Summary Reports, and denies all other allegations in paragraph 29.
- 11. Western Wireless admits the allegations in paragraph 30 of the Complaint that it has received certain invoices from certain Complainants containing charges for traffic allegedly delivered to those Complainants' exchanges, is without information sufficient to form a belief as to the truth of the allegations concerning the SWBT Cellular Transiting Usage Summary Reports, and denies all other allegations in paragraph 30.

12. Respondents admit the allegations in paragraph 31 of the Complaint that counsel for Complainants has contacted counsel for Respondents concerning amounts allegedly owed to Complainants and that the matter has not been resolved to date, but deny all other allegations in paragraph 31.

Affirmative Defenses

- 13. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that the Complaint fails to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
- 14. Further answering, Respondents state that Complainants' claims are barred by laches, waiver, and estoppel.
- 15. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that Complainants' claims are preempted and/or barred by state and federal law.
- 16. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that Complainants' claims are barred by applicable statutes of limitations.
- 17. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that Complainants' claims are barred by the Statute of Frauds.
- Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that Complainants' claims are barred by accord and satisfaction.
- 19. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that the relief sought by Complainants is barred by the doctrine of unclean hands.
- 20. Further answering, Respondents state affirmatively that the relief sought by Complainants is barred by the Commission's absence of power to award damages.

Wherefore, Respondents respectfully request that the Commission find in their favor on all allegations raised in the Complaint, deny all relief sought by Complainants in the Complaint, and enter its order granting all appropriate relief to Respondents.
