**ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On November 26, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) and the Staff of the Commission filed a Stipulation and Agreement (“Agreement”) stating that the Agreement resolves all issues in this proceeding. The Office of the Public Counsel is not a signatory to the Agreement, but MAWC and Staff represent that the Office of the Public Counsel has indicated that it will not oppose the Agreement.

The evidentiary hearing is set to begin on December 1, 2014. Given the apparent agreement of the parties, there is no need to maintain the procedural schedule. The procedural schedule will be suspended indefinitely.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule for this case is suspended until further order of the Commission.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
