STAFF'S SUPPLEMENT TO MOTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Supplement to Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule states:

1. On February 23, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) held a prehearing conference in this matter. The Complainant was not present and was not represented by counsel at that conference.

2. In the afternoon of February 23, 2000, a few hours after the prehearing conference had concluded, the Complainant appeared at the Commission's offices in Jefferson City, Missouri. The Complainant met with the undersigned counsel. Staff counsel did not try to speak with Complainant's counsel while Complainant was in the Commission's offices because when Staff counsel and counsel for Kansas City Power & Light and counsel for the Office of Public Counsel spoke with Complainant's counsel earlier, she advised that she was almost immediately leaving her office for approximately one week. The undersigned counsel related the dates of the




