**ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES TO  
STAFF’S NOTICE OF CORRECTION**

On February 25, 2022, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed an application (Application) requesting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for a water and sewer system in an area of Pettis County, Missouri (Monsees Lake Estates Subdivision). The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation that the Commission approve the Application subject to certain conditions on June 9, 2022. Subsequently, the Commission directed responses due June 21, 2022.

On June 21, 2022, MAWC filed its response that it had no objections to the proposed recommendations and conditions. Also on June 21, 2022, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed its Motion for Extension asking for a one-week extension to June 28, 2022, to file its response, which the Commission granted.

On June 24, 2022, Staff filed a Notice of Correction regarding a typographical error in the Staff Memorandum. Staff corrects the original Memorandum, page 18, Staff’s Recommendations, number 2, which originally stated, “Allow the Company to adopt the current water rate of the HOA at **\$38.30**.” The corrected statement is, “Allow the Company

to adopt the current water rate of the HOA at \$35.30.” The correction is made to match Staff’s finding set forth on page 11 of its Memorandum.

The Commission will shorten the time for responses to Staff’s Notice of Correction, including allowing MAWC to reassess its response filed June 21, 2022.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No party is required to respond, but any party that wishes to respond to Staff’s Notice of Correction shall do so on or before June 28, 2022.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
