NOTICE OF CORRECTION IN INITIAL BRIEF

COME NOW the Midwest Energy Consumers' Group (collectively referred to herein as "MECG"), and for its Notice of Correction in its Initial Brief, respectfully states as follows:

1. On March 22, 2017, MECG filed its Initial Brief in this matter. On page 90 of that brief, MECG asks that the Commission set a return on equity for KCPL at the lower end of the range established by MECG witness Gorman. MECG then inadvertently indicates that the lower end of this range was <u>9.9% to 10.2%</u>. This was mistaken.

2. As indicated at pages 9, 14, 15, 17, 18, 27 and 36 of that brief, Mr. Gorman's return on equity analysis shows a range of 8.9% to 9.5% with a midpoint of 9.2%. Therefore, the lower end of the range should have indicated <u>8.9% to 9.2%</u>. In fact, the correct recitation of the lower end of the range was properly indicated on pages 9, 14 and 36. Counsel inadvertently indicated a different range on page 90.

3. Through this pleading, MECG seeks to correct and clarify that its position is that KCPL should be awarded a return on equity at the lower end of Mr. Gorman's range (8.9% to 9.2%). As such, the reference on page 90 should be corrected.

WHEREFORE, MECG respectfully requests that the Commission recognize this correction to page 90 of its Initial Brief.
