The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting an expedited date for filing any reply to the Missouri-American Water Company's response ("motion")<sup>1</sup> to Staff's recommendation.<sup>2</sup> Among other requests and arguments, the motion proposes a procedural schedule within which the Commission could meet the statutory deadline for deciding this action. Before ruling on the motion, the Commission will consider input from the parties. But the schedule includes filing prepared testimony one week after the filing of the motion, and the issuance of this order, so the Commission will set an expedited date for responses to the motion.<sup>3</sup>

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than May 7, 2015, at noon, any party may file a reply to the *Response* and Objection to Staff Recommendation, Request for Regulatory Asset, and Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule.
