The Commission is setting the time in which any party to the action in File No. WM-2015-0231 ("earlier case") may show cause why the Commission should not cancel the certificate of convenience and necessity, and the tariff, of Ozark Shores Water Company ("Ozark Shores").

Ozark Shores was the subject of the earlier case. In that case, the Commission granted an application for a public water district to acquire Ozark Shores. ¹ The acquisition was scheduled to close on June 30, 2015. ² If the acquisition has occurred, no public utility remains to do business under the certificate of convenience and necessity, and the tariff, of Ozark Shores. ³

Therefore, the Commission will set the time for any party to the earlier case to show cause why the Commission should not cancel the certificate of convenience and necessity, and the tariff, of Ozark Shores.
