On February 16, 2007, Ms. Orler, one of the intervenors in this matter, filed a motion requesting the Commission to Dismiss the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Gail Snyder filed on February 13. Ms. Orler correctly recites Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.130(8)'s directive that no party shall be permitted to supplement prefiled prepared direct testimony. However, Mr. Snyder's testimony, while being inartfully captioned, is really merely direct testimony because it was filed prior to the deadline elapsed for the filing of direct testimony. Testimony becomes "supplemental" when a party attempts to file additional testimony after a filing deadline has passed. Ms. Orler's motion shall be denied
