**ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE***

On April 13, 2012, the following attorneys filed a petition for leave to appear and participate in this matter *pro hac vice* as attorneys for Complainant, Halo Wireless, Inc.

("Halo"):

Jennifer M. Larson: admitted to practice before the courts of the state of Texas, but not admitted to practice before Missouri courts.

Troy P. Majoue: admitted to practice before the courts of the states of Louisiana, Texas and Alabama, but not admitted to practice before Missouri courts.

Steven H. Thomas: admitted to practice before the courts of the states of New York and Texas, but not admitted to practice before Missouri courts.

W. Scott McCollough: admitted to practice before the courts of the state of Texas, but not admitted to practice before Missouri courts.

Halo has designated Louis A. Huber, III and Daniel R. Young, members in good standing of the Missouri Bar, as local counsel. The petition includes a copy of the check from the law firm payable to the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court to demonstrate compliance with Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m). Petitioners state that they have not yet received the receipt from the Missouri Supreme Court, but that they will file the receipt when it is received.

The Commission has considered the petition and finds that the request to appear *pro hac vice* complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03.<sup>1</sup> The Commission will therefore admit Jennifer M. Larson, Troy P. Majoue, Steven H. Thomas, and W. Scott McCollough *pro hac vice* to appear on behalf of Halo Wireless, Inc.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The petition of Jennifer M. Larson, Troy P. Majoue, Steven H. Thomas, and W. Scott McCollough for leave to appear and participate as counsel for Halo Wireless, Inc. *pro hac vice* is granted.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
