- 3 The Staff of the Commission has brought a
- 4 complaint against M.L.M. Telecommunications, Incorporated,
- 5 alleging that M.L.M. has been operating as a
- 6 telecommunications company without a tariff and under a
- fictitious name that has not been approved by the
- 8 Commission.
- 9 Staff has asked that the Commission find
- 10 M.L.M. in violation of Sections 392.221.1 and 392.480
- 11 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, Commission
- Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(16), and the Commission's order in
- 13 Case No. CA-2002-1140.
- 14 Staff asked that the Commission revoke
