The Commission established this case in 2002 to examine Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P.'s costs of providing certain unbundled network elements (UNEs) that had been at issue in an earlier arbitration case involving the Missouri 271 agreement. The Commission has been holding the case in abeyance since 2003, pending resolution of the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Proceeding.

On December 30, 2005, the Commission directed the parties to file pleadings by January 17, indicating whether the Commission needed to proceed with this case, or whether it should be closed. Only Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, and the Staff of the Commission filed responses. AT&T Missouri and Staff agree that there are no remaining issues, and recommend that the case be closed.

The Commission agrees that there are no remaining issues and will close this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this case shall be closed.

2. That this order shall become effective on January 19, 2006.
