On June 18, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed, with the Missouri Public Service Commission, an expedited application to allow the company to alter its status from a Texas limited partnership to a Missouri corporation. The Commission concludes that good cause has been shown pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16).

The Commission finds that proper parties shall be given notice and an opportunity to respond to AT&T Missouri's application in this matter. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to the parties to this docket. Parties, including the Staff of the Commission, wishing to oppose the alteration of AT&T Missouri's status shall file a response with the Commission on or before June 24, 2007.
