

Ameren Missouri has been working on this calculation for some time, it requires additional time to complete this work in order to ensure that the calculation does comport with the Court's opinion, the statute, and the rules. The Company has had initial meetings with Commission Staff and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) to seek their input on this issue, but those discussions indicate that some additional work and consultation would promote completing this work. There is insufficient time prior to April 15, when the Compliance Plan would normally be due, to do so.

4. After discussing this matter with Staff and OPC, it is apparent that approximately six additional weeks will be required in order to complete working through the issues that remain and to ensure the calculation is consistent with the Court's Opinion, the RES statute, and the Commission's RES regulations.

5. The Company has consulted with Staff, who have authorized the undersigned to state that they do not oppose this request.

OTHER INFORMATION

6. Ameren Missouri is a corporation in good standing, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri, with its principal office and place of business at One Ameren Plaza, 1901 Chouteau Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri 63103. Ameren Missouri has previously filed a Certificate of Corporate Good Standing in File No. EA-2013-0316, which is incorporated by reference. Applicant's Fictitious Name Registration was previously filed with the Commission in File No. EN-2011-0069, which is incorporated by reference.

7. The Applicant is engaged in providing electric and gas utility services in portions of Missouri as a public utility under the jurisdiction of this Commission. Ameren

Missouri has no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal court or agency within the past three (3) years which involve customer service or rates, other than cases currently pending before the Commission (EC-2012-0050, EC-2012-0365 and EC-2013-0376) and appeals pending in the Western District Court of Appeals (WD75980 and WD75403). Ameren Missouri has no annual reports or assessment fees that are overdue.

8. All correspondence, communications, notices, orders and decisions of the Commission with respect to this matter should be sent to the undersigned counsel.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri requests the Commission grant it a variance from the April 15th filing requirement for its RES Compliance Plan and instead allow Ameren Missouri to make the filing by May 27, 2013.
