ORDER SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On January 30, 2013, the complainants filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. That complaint alleges in three counts that Ameren Missouri is in non-compliance with Missouri's Renewable Energy Standards law, Sections 393.1020-1030, RSMo (Supp. 2012). Ameren Missouri filed its answer to that complaint on March 4. The Commission now must determine how to proceed to consider that complaint.

To assist in that determination, the Commission will schedule a procedural conference at which the parties may discuss whether there are any factual matters in dispute, whether an evidentiary hearing is necessary, and when any such hearing or other procedure shall occur.
