On January 30, 2013, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri; Missouri Coalition for the Environment; Missouri Solar Energy Industries Association; Wind on the Wires; The Alternative Energy Company, LLC; StraightUp Solar; and Missouri Solar Applications LLC filed a complaint with the Commission against Kansas City Power & Light Company, a copy of which is enclosed.
