ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STATEMENT OF FACTS

Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District has filed a Motion for Summary Judgment in this matter. MSD argues that there are no factual disputes and that summary judgment should be granted in its favor. Missouri-American Water opposes MSD's motion and although it does not allege that there are factual disputes, it points out that MSD has omitted certain facts.

It appears that the parties will be able to agree on the facts of this matter. The Commission will therefore require the parties to file a Statement of Facts. Each fact shall be numbered and be one sentence long. This Statement of Facts shall be filed in lieu of the remaining items to be filed according to the procedural schedule.

If, however, the parties are unable to agree on a Statement of Facts, then the procedural schedule shall continue as is.

A hearing has been scheduled in this matter for March 7, 2007. If the parties have filed a Statement of Facts, then that day shall be used for oral argument of the legal issue

presented in this matter. If, however, the parties were unable to agree on the facts, then that day will be used to present evidence as well as oral argument.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District and Missouri-American Water shall file a
 Statement of Facts no later than February 14, 2007.
- 2. If the parties are unable to agree on the facts, then the procedural schedule shall continue as set out by previous order.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on January 29, 2007.
