**STAFF’S MOTION TO RENEW THE CANCELLATION OF THE CERTIFICATES OF
SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ASSOCIATED TARIFF OF UNITED AMERICAN
TECHNOLOGY**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and in support of its motion states as follows:

1. On February 13, 2014, the Commission issued an order canceling United American Technology, Inc.’s (“UAT”) certificates of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and its associated tariffs (Tracking No. JX-2007-0783). The effective date for the Commission’s Order was February 25, 2014.

2. On February 24, 2014, UAT filed a *Motion to Stay Order*, indicating that UAT wishes to retain its certificates of service authority within the State of Missouri and that UAT was in the process of filing with the Staff of the Commission all outstanding annual reports and working to pay any universal service fund fees that are due. UAT requested the Commission stay the effective date of the Commission’s *Order Canceling Certificate and Accompanying Tariff* while the company attempts to work with the Staff of the Commission to resolve the issue.

3. Also on February 24, 2014, the Commission filed its *Order Staying Effective Date of Order Cancelling Certificate and Accompanying Tariff*, granting UAT’s request to

stay the effective date of the cancellation of their certificates of service authority. The Commission further ordered Staff to file a status report no later than April 1, 2014.

4. On March 31, 2014, the Staff filed its *Status Report* in compliance with the Commission order, stating that the Company and Staff were working to acquire missing documentation and bring the Company up to date on all past-due reports and fees.

5. On April 1, 2014, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Staff to File Status Report*, with Staff's status report to be filed no later than May 20, 2014.

6. On April 16, 2014, Staff received a written statement from the Company's attorney indicating that the Company now wishes to cease its operations in Missouri. Furthermore, as of the filing of Staff's *Status Report*, the Company has ceased working with Staff to resolve discrepancies in its annual report and net jurisdictional revenue report. UAT also continues to be delinquent on the payment of the majority of its Missouri Universal Service Fund fees.

WHEREFORE, Staff renews its motion to cancel the certificates of service authority and associated tariff of United American Technology, Inc. to provide interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. Staff further requests that the Commission require the Company to notify the Commission when transfer of customers to another provider is complete.
