Dear Ms. Happy:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph #2 of the Order Closing Investigation issued July 29, 2020, please be advised that Assurance Wireless USA, LP (“Assurance,” f/k/a Virgin Mobile USA, L.P.), Sprint Corporation (“Sprint”), and T-Mobile US, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) (collectively, “the Company”) and the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) entered into a consent decree pursuant to which the Company will cause a \$200,000,000 payment to be made to the United States Treasury and implement a robust compliance plan.

The consent decree is publicly available at <https://docs.fcc.gov/public/attachments/DA-20-1295A1.pdf>. The matter has now been resolved by the payment and the consent decree, and the FCC has “agree[d] that it will not seek any further monetary forfeitures under . . . [47 U.S.C. § 503] in connection with any violations of the Lifeline rules by the Company[.]” *Id.*
