ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Issue Date: October 27, 2021 Effective Date: November 26, 2021

This order approves an Interconnection Agreement between the parties filed by Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC (TWCIS).

On September 12, 2021, TWCIS filed an application with the Commission for approval of an Interconnection Agreement between itself and Consolidated Communications of Missouri Company (Consolidated Communications) under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. TWCIS is certificated with the Commission as a competitive local exchange carrier. Consolidated Communications is certificated with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange carrier.

Although Consolidated Communications is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On September 23, 2021, the Commission issued an order making Consolidated Communications a party in this case and directing any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than October 8, 2021. No requests for hearing were filed.

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any Interconnection Agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may reject an Agreement if it finds that the Agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

On October 19, 2021, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff recommends that the Agreement be approved and notes that the Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Interconnection Agreement between TWCIS and Consolidated Communications, filed on September 12, 2021, is approved.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on November 26, 2021.
 - 3. This file may be closed on November 27, 2021.
