On August 24, 2005, the Office of the Public Counsel and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, filed a notice indicating that they rescind the Stipulation and Agreement filed in the case on August 1, 2005. Public Counsel and CenturyTel also request that the Commission schedule a prehearing conference so that the parties can discuss the next procedural steps.

The Commission agrees that a prehearing conference would be appropriate. The parties are hereby informed, however, that the Commission expects that one or more Commissioners may attend the beginning of the prehearing conference, and that the Commissioners may have questions for the parties.
