In their verified joint application, which was filed on February 6, 2008, Broadview Networks, Inc. ("Broadview"), ATX Licensing, Inc. ("ATX"), and A.R.C. Networks, Inc. d/b/a InfoHighway Communications ("InfoHighway") (collectively, "Applicants") seek the Commission's authorization to transfer a substantial portion of the Missouri long distance customer base of ATX and InfoHighway to Broadview. The Applicants further request that the Commission waive its anti-slamming rule (4 CSR 240-33.150) so as to allow the proposed customer consolidation to take place without requiring the written authorization of each such customer beforehand. The Applicants have also requested priority treatment and consideration of their application under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16).

The Commission will order Staff to file a pleading informing the Commission when it will be able to file its recommendation in this matter. This pleading shall also address the Applicants' request for expedited treatment under 4 CSR 240-2.080(16).

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall, by no later than February 29, 2008, file a pleading informing the Commission when it will be able to file its recommendation in this matter. This pleading shall also address the Applicants' request for expedited treatment under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16).
