ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On July 10, 2012, YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax") filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31. On August 3, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") filed a Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff. The Commission granted the motion to suspend on August 8, and set a prehearing conference for August 22.

On August 17, YMax filed a Motion for Continuance. YMax stated that additional time before a prehearing conference could benefit the parties by giving them more time to discuss possible resolution of their dispute.

To that end, YMax asks the Commission to continue the prehearing conference to September 4. YMax states that its counsel has discussed the motion with all parties, and there is no objection.

The Commission finds YMax's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion for continuance filed by YMax Communications Corp., is granted.

A prehearing conference shall be held on September 4, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, a building that meets accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
