ORDER REJECTING FILING FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH
COMMISSION REGULATIONS

On November 17, 2005, SBC created this case by filing a letter from Susan Littlefield, Manager-Regulatory for SBC Operations, Inc., in San Antonio, Texas. Ms. Littlefield's letter purports to submit for approval an amendment to the existing interconnection agreement between SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri. Such amendment is subject to approval by this Commission pursuant to Section 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

SBC's application does not indicate that the submitted amendment has previously been approved by this Commission. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.513(6)(C) requires that applications for approval of proposed amendments to interconnection agreements that have not previously been approved by this Commission must comply with the filing requirements identified in 4 CSR 240-2.040, 4 CSR 240-2.060, and 4 CSR 240-2.080.

The cited regulations impose numerous requirements on any application filed with the Commission. SBC's application does not comply with many of those requirements. In

particular, 4 CSR 240-2.080(1) requires that every pleading filed with the Commission be signed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri. SBC's application is not signed by an attorney and must be rejected.

If SBC wishes to appropriately resubmit its application, it may do so in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That SBC's application for approval of an amendment to the interconnection agreement between SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri is rejected for failure to comply with applicable filing requirements.
2. That the Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this order to SBC's Missouri legal counsel.
3. That this order shall become effective on November 18, 2005.
