ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF BONA FIDE REQUEST
FOR TERMINATION OF A RURAL EXEMPTION
UNDER 47 U.S.C. SECTION 251(f)(1)(A),
SCHEDULING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE,
SETTING DATE FOR INTERVENTION, ADDING PARTY,
AND DIRECTING STAFF INVESTIGATION

On July 2, 2007, Big River Telephone Company, LLC, filed a Notice of Bona Fide Request for Interconnection, Services and Network Elements from BPS Telephone Company pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 251(f)(1). Big River has requested interconnection with BPS and BPS has refused such interconnection based on a rural telephone company exemption.

Big River requests that the Commission direct BPS to show whether it is eligible as a rural telephone company, including whether it provides video programming, and why any applicable exemption under Section 251(f)(1)¹ should not be terminated. In addition, Big River requests that the Commission direct its Staff to conduct an investigation of BPS to determine the economic impact of Big River's request, the technical feasibility of Big River's

request, and the consistency of Big River's request with the applicable portions of Section 254. Big River further asks the Commission to immediately schedule a conference of the parties to discuss the procedural schedule to be set in this matter. Finally, Big River requests that upon conclusion of the proceedings, that the Commission terminate any applicable exemption under Section 251(f)(1) as to BPS, at least with regard to Big River's request, and establish an implementation schedule for compliance with Big River's request. Because BPS is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add it as a party to this case.

Section 251(f)(1)(B) requires the Commission to complete an inquiry for the purpose of determining whether to terminate the exemption no later than October 30, 2007. The Commission is required to terminate the exemption if the request is not unduly economically burdensome, is technically feasible, and is consistent with Section 254. Thus, the Commission shall direct BPS to file a response to Big River's requests.

The Commission shall also direct its Staff to begin the necessary inquiries to advise the Commission regarding the economic impact, technical feasibility, and consistency with Section 254.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed an opportunity to file a request for intervention. The Commission also finds that notice of this application shall be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.

Because of the expedited nature of this case, the Commission will promptly schedule a procedural conference. If any of the parties or applicants for intervention desire
