ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

On November 30, 2007, Richard J. Wilhelm filed a motion asking the Commission to quash a subpoena duces tecum, issued on behalf of the Staff of the Commission, that required Wilhelm to produce certain documents relating to Universal Utilities, Inc. In large part, Wilhelm's motion to quash was based on Staff's failure to coordinate the demand for production of documents with a deposition of Wilhelm. Subsequently, on December 12, Staff filed a Notice of Deposition indicating that Wilhelm's deposition has been scheduled for December 19.

With the scheduling of the deposition, it appears that much of the basis for Wilhelm's motion to quash has been eliminated. Therefore, the Commission will direct Wilhelm to file a pleading indicating whether he still wants the Commission to rule on his motion to quash.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than December 20, 2007, Richard J. Wilhelm shall file a pleading indicating whether he still wants the Commission to rule on all or any portion of his Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum or Require Advancement of Costs.

2. This order shall become effective on December 14, 2007.
