#### ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

On February 8, 2005, Southtown Utilities Company, Inc. filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission for certificates of service authority to provide water and sewer service. On August 23, 2005, the Commission issued an order approving the applications. As part of the order, the company was directed to submit separate sewer and water tariffs sheets comprised of the rates and service area descriptions reflected in that order.

On November 14, 2005, the company submitted tariffs as directed by the Commission. The Staff of the Commission filed its recommendation on December 6, 2005. Staff states that it believes the tariffs are in compliance with the Commission's order and advises the Commission to approve the tariffs to become effective on December 15, 2005.

The Commission has reviewed the tariffs and finds them to be in compliance with the Commission's order. The Commission will therefore approve the tariffs.
