On January 14, 2009, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR 240-3.600, Dale Whiteside and Whiteside Hidden Acres, L.L.C, (hereafter “Applicant”) filed two applications (as captioned in the style of these cases above) with the Missouri Public Service Commission.¹ Applicant requests that the Commission grant it authority to own, operate, control, manage, improve and maintain a water and sewer system for the public in Hickory County, Missouri.

On February 17, the Staff of the Commission (hereafter “Staff”) filed a Status Report. In that report, Staff states that it anticipates receiving information from Applicant no later than March 10, and that Staff plans to file a status report or recommendation no later than April 7.

The Commission will order Staff to comply with its planned reporting schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a status report or a recommendation no later than April 7, 2009.
